General guidelines

Students must carry the following documents for verification/submission:

1. Statement of Marks: Class 10 and Class 12 original with one set of photocopies.
2. Undergraduate Degree Marks Card original with one set of photocopies.
3. Provisional degree certificate/Degree Certificate original with one photocopy.
4. Transfer Certificate (TC) from the last qualified institution in original.
5. Migration Certificate from qualifying University (applicable for all students except those studying in Karnataka) in original.

Students will have to purchase a laptop at their own cost if required for the programme.

Usage of mobile phones are banned in the University buildings and classrooms.

Marks are awarded for good attendance. Students having less than 85% of attendance in each semester/trimester will not be permitted to take the examinations.

The responsibility of satisfying the eligibility criteria for admission rests with the student/candidate. Issue of the E-Admission card for the program and admission does not imply that the eligibility criteria are satisfied.

The University ID card is a smart card, which has a South Indian bank ATM card with a chip containing the student's personal details. All transactions within the University campus after commencement of classes, including fees payment will be processed only through this card. Students are therefore required to open an account at South Indian Bank. Students are required to carry their Original Aadhar Card / PAN Card / Passport.
