**The Concept of Inclusive Education:** Understanding the philosophy and objectives of inclusive education and its significance in promoting diversity and equality in the educational sector.

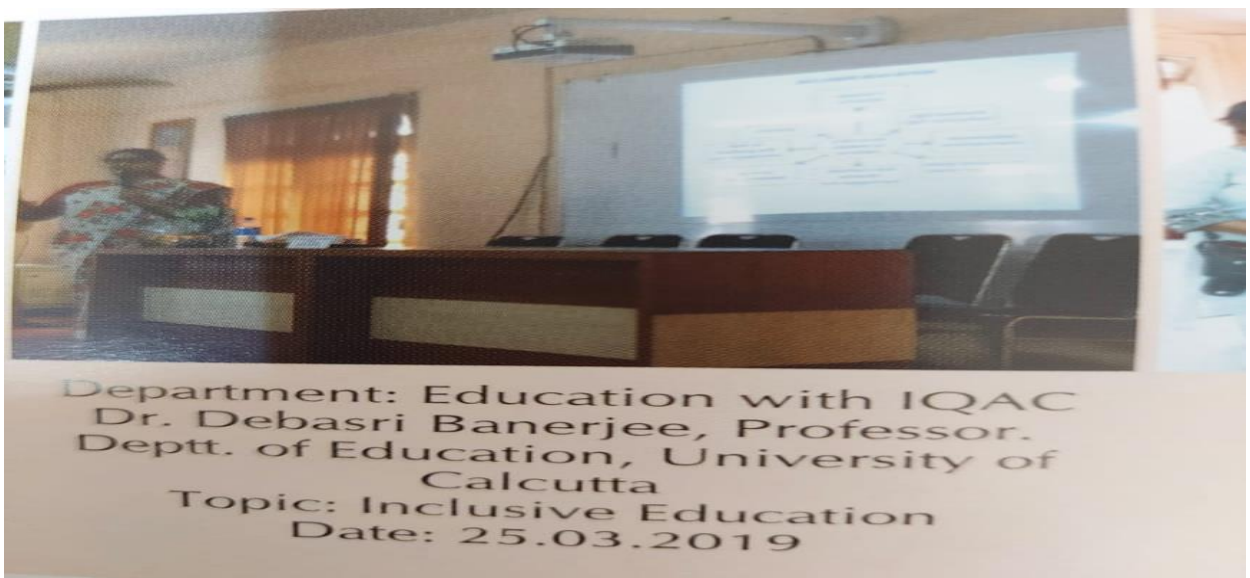
**Models of Inclusive Education:** Examination of different models and frameworks that support inclusive practices, including differentiated instruction and universal design for learning.
